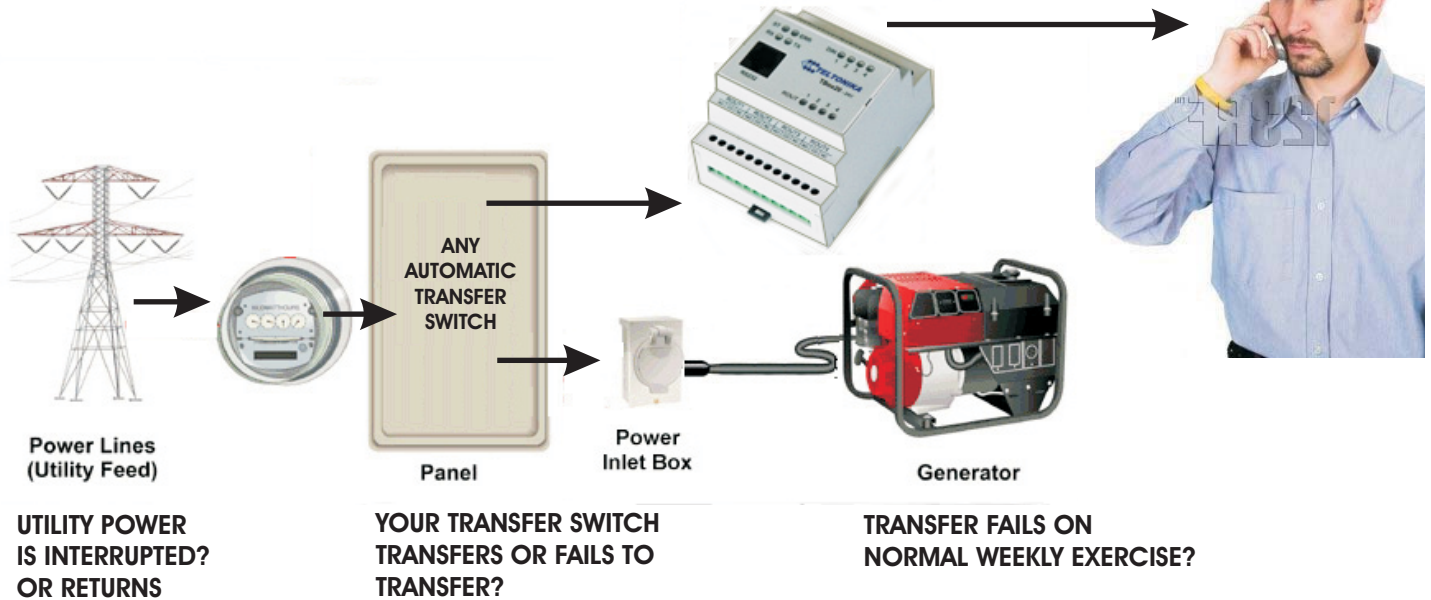


WILL YOUR CELL PHONE "TEXT MESSAGE" YOU WHEN:



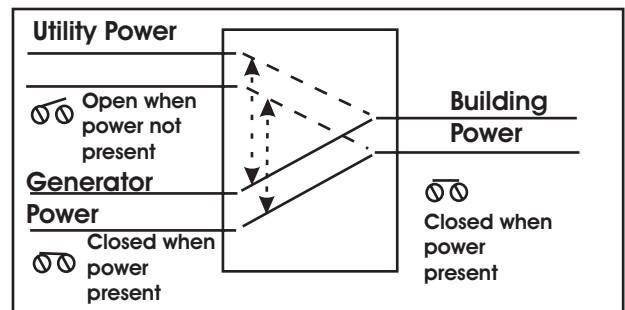
UTILITY FAILURE

Hospitals, Police, Industry. Radio and TV stations all require back up power when the power utility fails. But how do you know that your emergency generator worked when you needed it. You exercise it weekly and maintain it in top condition. But if you knew you had a problem there is probably something you could do.

And wouldn't it be comforting if power was lost and you were advised that your generator is supplying you with back up power just fine? The TextMitter Transfer Switch monitor sends you a text message to your cell phone (or E-mails your PC) when your transfer switch detects a power loss.

THE GENERATOR TRANSFERS POWER TO YOUR BUILDING

Giving you the comfort of mind is exactly what the TextMitter does. You get an initial message that the utility power has been lost. Then a second message that power has successfully been transferred to your building or that it had not. You are now in control and can act immediately if necessary.



WORKS WITH AUTOMATIC TRANSFER SWITCHES

The TextMitter Transfer Switch monitor works with any automatic transfer Switch. An auxiliary switch automatically closes when power is present. Thus when the utility power is lost, that switch opens and in doing so, a text message is sent to any cell phone. Subsequently the generator and building switches close. Success is reported by text message.

THE GENERATOR FAILS ITS WEEKLY EXERCISE

Because the unfailing operation of back up power is critical, the transfer switch will often exercise the generator weekly. You may choose it on every Monday at noon. Because it could be difficult to synchronize time between the switch and the TextMitter, a window (you select when and how long) in which the generator might start is available. If the generator starts during this window time, no text message will be sent. If it does not, you will receive a text message that the exercise has failed. The TextMitter will check to update its internal clock periodically with a national time service.
